We offer i-go scheme concessionary discounts at our leisure centres and swimming pools.

Show your i-go card to reception at Seaford Head Swimming Pool to receive concessionary rates; £3.30 swims, plus get one carer in for free if they are assisting.

An i-go card gives you discounts and accessibility information at leisure centres, attractions, activities and clubs in East Sussex.

You can get an i-go card if you:

- Are 0-25 years old
- Live or receive education in East Sussex; and have special needs or a disability. This includes learning difficulties, physical disabilities and autism.
- A diagnosis isn't necessary

Seaford Head Swimming Pool is open Monday - Friday 7am - 9pm, Saturday 8am - 5pm and Sunday 8am - 3pm. Bank Holiday times vary, please contact the centre for more information.

Planning a Visit

Arrival

- Accessible car park offering one disabled car parking space - this is signposted from the main car park
- There is a ramp with a handrail leading to the entrance
- The main entrance has a manual sliding door and a ledge
- For wheelchair users there is an accessible door which can be opened upon request. Please ring the bell by the door or call the centre
- Lowered reception counter – accessible for wheelchair users
- Please ask on arrival if you need assistance to gain entry via the swing gate in reception
- A radar key is available at reception upon request for access to accessible toilet/changing room

Noise & Lights

- The radio is played in the pool area
- Fire alarms are tested weekly during opening hours, please contact the centre for more information

General Space & Swimming Pools

- The floors inside are smooth
- Most areas are suitable height for wheelchair users
- There is a chair hoist to access the main pool – please ask at reception for assistance upon arrival

Toilets & Changing Rooms

- We have one accessible toilet with hand dryer
- We have one accessible changing room with toilet which includes a hand dryer, handrails and two pull down seats
- There are lowered hand rails for support in the change as well as on the main door
- The changing room has a large bench and shower with a pull-down hand rail
- The changing room needs a radar key to access. This is available upon request at reception if needed
- Female and Male changing rooms have a footbath upon exiting to the pool, the accessible changing room does not

Stairs, Steps and Lifts

- The stairs leading to the building have a handrail - we also have ramp access to the main building
- The building is all on one level

Food & Drink

- We allow people with special dietary requirements to bring their own food
